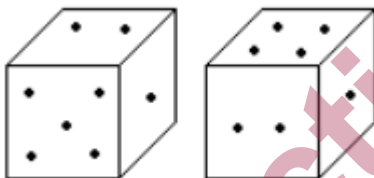
I. All roads can be trains.
